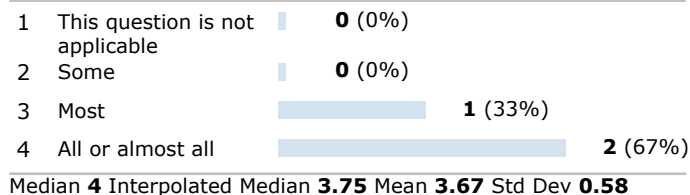

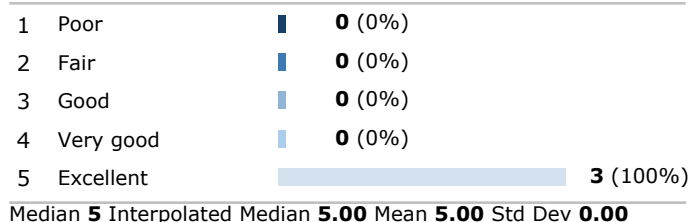

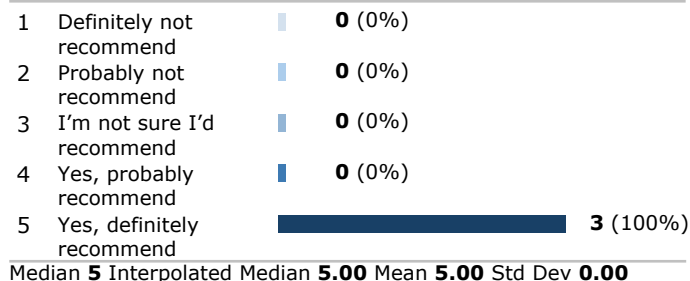
**1 What percentage of the work (including reading) assigned for this course did you complete on schedule? N=3**



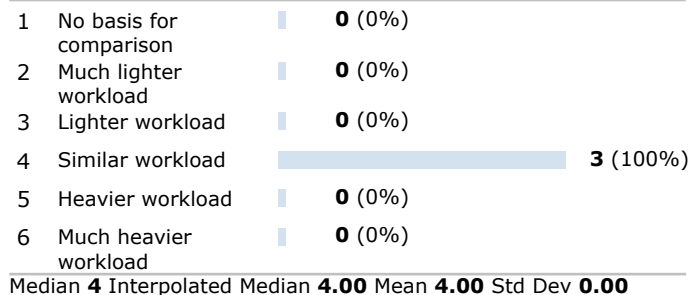
**2 What is your overall assessment of the course? N=3**



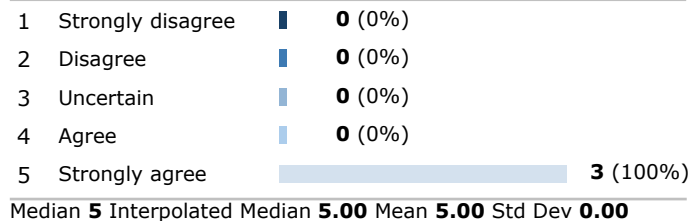

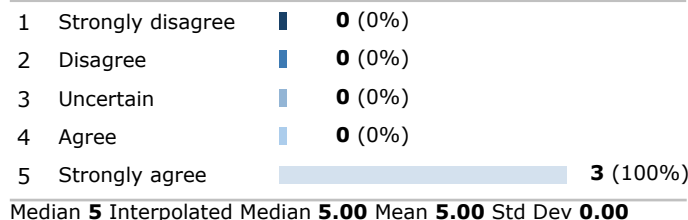

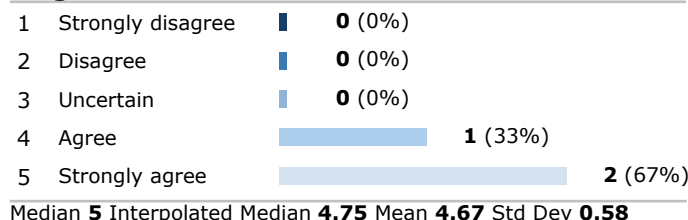

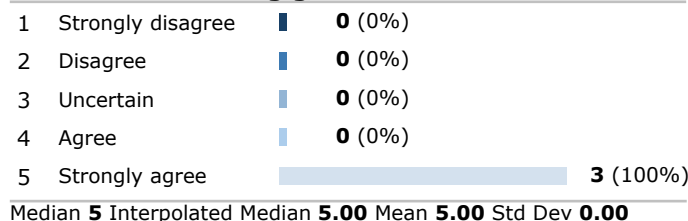

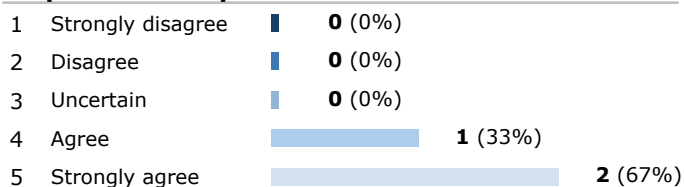
